With its prominent position at an altitude of almost 2,000 metres above sea level, sweeping views over Lake St. Moritz and 60 suites designed by Carlo Rampazzi, the Carlton St. Moritz is one of the most stunning hotels in Switzerland. Guests are treated to culinary surprises and exquisite fare in both the Carlton Hotel's restaurants, the Romanoff (14 GaultMillau points) and the Da Vittorio - St. Moritz (1 Michelin star, 18 GaultMillau points). Covering 1,200 square metres, the Carlton's spa is spread across three floors and boasts an indoor and outdoor pool, a spacious spa area and the luxuriously appointed treatment rooms offering personal well-being.
